THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW IF THIS IS YOUR FIRST TRIAL:

- You MUST have a valid Dog ID Number from AAC to compete for AAC qualifiers and titles.
- Dogs may enter and run FEO without a number.
- Your dog will need to be measured by a judge Saturday morning.
- A complete rulebook is available with AAC membership, or a read only rulebook is available online at www.aac.ca

CONFIRMATION: will be emailed, or mailed to you if you don't provide an email address. If you do not receive a confirmation by 1 week prior to the trial date, or if there are errors, please notify the Trial Secretary as soon as possible. This will help avoid delays on the day of the trial.

TRIAL SITE: This trial will be held inside.

CRATING & SET-UP: There will be limited space for set up inside the barn.

AAC ID CARDS, CHECK IN AND MEASURING: If your dog does not have a completed AAC card, please order it well in advance (form enclosed) from AAC. You must have your dog measured and your card marked with that measurement before checking-in. Measuring will be available; Saturday between 7:15 a.m.-7:30 a.m. Check in starts at 7:00 a.m.

EQUIPMENT FAMILIARIZATION / WALK THROUGH: Starters dogs only; Contact equipment only. Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 7:30 a.m. Sat walk through 7:50 a.m

FIRST DOG ON THE LINE: Saturday 8 a.m.

CLASS CHANGE/MOVE-UPS: Same day move-ups will be allowed. Please report move- ups to scorekeeping table. Move ups from prior trials must be reported no later than noon Friday before the trial date - please email the trial secretary of any move ups immediately at pawssquad@gmail.com

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Flat ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th Place. All Qualifying runs will receive an official Qualifying Rosette. MADC, ATChC, MSCDC, Bronze, Silver & Gold, will receive a large rosette.

TRIAL RESULTS: The Trial results will be posted onsite after completion of the class. We will also be posting final results on the Paws Squad website, www.pawssquad.ca, within a few days of the completion of the trial.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry by AAC and Paws Squad Canine Sports Club (the "Organizing Club' and the opportunity to have the Dog participate, compete in and/or be judged at this event or trial (the "Event" I, the undersigned, agree as follows:
1. I certify that I am the actual owner of the Dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner of the Dog and that the Dog is not a hazard to persons, property or other dogs.
 I agree that AAC or the Organizing Club for the Event may refuse my entry for any reason that it deems to b sufficient.
3. I understand and acknowledge that participation in the Event carries certain risks, including, but not limite to injuries (including serious injuries and death) to myself, the Dog, another dog under my control or person attending as my guests (my "Related Parties"), damage to property and other losses. I waive any and a claims that I have or may have in the future against, and release from all liability and agree not to sue AAC the Organizing Club or any of the directors, executives, committees, representatives, employees, volunteer or agents of either AAC or the Organizing Club (the "Personnel") for any injury, death, property damage of other loss that I or my Related Parties sustain due to any cause whatsoever, including negligence, breach of contract, breach of duty, statutory or otherwise, or mistakes or errors of judgment of any kind.
4. I assume full responsibility for the conduct of myself and my Related Parties during the entirety of the Even I agree to indemnify and save harmless AAC, the Organizing Club and the Personnel from and against any an all claims that may be made against them or costs, fees, expenses or liability (including, without limitation lawyers' fees on a solicitor and own client basis) incurred by AAC, the Organizing Club or the Personnel that may arise due to:

Reminders to Exhibitors

- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of AAC rules and regulations, including but not limited to the following:
- This event is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, purebred or mixed breed, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or any dogs showing signs of aggression.
- Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the rules and regulations of the AAC (rules are available online www.aac.ca).
- No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, including during familiarization and course-walking. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children.

- All dogs must be penned, crated or on leash when not in the ring. All dogs must be under control when exiting the ring. Any dog engaging in aggressive or out of control behavior upon exit of the ring may be disqualified and / or required to leave the show grounds and NO REFUND of fees shall be given.
- Exhibitors must keep crating and exercise areas clean. Please pick up after yourself and your dogs. We need to keep this great venue available to us and other dog clubs!
- Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show grounds and no refund of fees paid will be made.
- If an exhibitor must be asked to leave the show grounds for any reason, they will not be issued a refund.
- There will be no refund after the closing date for dogs that are withdrawn, with the exception of bitches in season or sick/injured dogs if we are provided with a vet's certificate.
